

A Special meeting of the Town Council of the Town of Williamsport was held at 6:00 p.m. on Wednesday, June 24, 2020 at the Warren County Learning Center with the following officers present – Mike Hutchison, Council President and Council members Traci Latoz and Jim Lanham. Also present were Town Attorneys Mallory Redlin and Ingrid Barce, Ted Latoz, Amy Cushman, and Craig Greenwood.

The purpose of this special meeting is to review and revise the Town Code.

Mike Hutchison called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m.

Ingrid Barce presented the Council with the revised Town Code. The Council discussed the revisions to update several of the Town’s ordinances and remove some that are no longer necessary or valid.

Mike Hutchison discussed the Town of Williamsport’s Electric Utility. Mike Hutchison stated after reviewing the Town’s revenue and costs for operating the electric utility, he felt it would be in the Town’s best interest to sell the electric utility.

Mike Hutchison made a motion to begin the process of selling the Town of Williamsport’s Electric Utility. Traci Latoz seconded the motion. Voted and passed.

Mallory Redlin advised the Council that the Town of Williamsport’s Electric Utility was not on the agenda for the evening, and therefore should not be an item voted on at the special meeting.

Mike Hutchison retracted his motion. Traci Latoz retracted her second of the motion. The Council will discuss the Town’s Electric Utility at a future meeting.

Mike Hutchison made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Traci Latoz seconded the motion. Voted and passed.
